**To have your specimen identified, please return this form with the
Specimen Identification Form and your specimen**

1) I agree to submit a piece of my specimen, at least 1 inch in diameter, for testing. I will **NOT** send photos or the results of other laboratories' analyses.

2) I agree to send only **one** sample at a time.

3) I understand that it may take up to **6 months** to analyze and identify my specimen, and I will not repeatedly contact the Center to check on my specimen, as this slows the identification process of not just my specimen, but the over 500 specimens the Center receives every year.

4) I agree that the Center is at no time responsible for my specimen.

5) I agree that I will not submit any specimens purchased from ANYBODY, since the goal of the Center's identification service is to identify new specimens, not confirm claims made by other entities.

6) I agree that it is solely my responsibility, and not the Center's, to obtain delivery confirmation from my shipping carrier. I agree that I will not call or email to confirm whether the Center has received my specimen.
